Every participant will most certainly be able to acquire the necessary practical new skills to improving their game before the June Division 3 and July Division 2 European Championships in Hungary (in Zanka, whoohoo!) and Latvia. By the end of the Test European Championship, the players and coaches will have a better feeling for what they most urgently need work on to improve their FIRA rankings at the European Championship.

It is my hope and intention that all nations involved will remember to make use of all the fundamental elements of rugby, most importantly the FUN factor, and that they will return home with great memories from sharing in the rugby spirit and enjoying the atmosphere of our extended rugby family.
